

# Product Safety Recall



## 30 Seconds Outdoor Cleaner 2L Hose End 30 Seconds Deck and Driveway Cleaner 2L Hose End

Sold at various retailers between September 2022 and January 2023

**Defect:** Some bottles may have a faulty breather cap

**Hazard:** The solution in some bottles may leak from the breather cap if tipped over. Contact with the solution may cause skin and/or eye damage and may be harmful if the contents are ingested or inhaled.

**What to do:** Wear protective clothing, gloves and face/eye protection and check that the breather cap is secured. If the cap is secure and there are no leaks, then read the instructions and use as directed. Store out of reach of children.

If you identify a leak, or are unsure, place the bottle upright in a plastic bag, seal with a cable tie or packaging tape and place in a secure container out of reach of children until collection can be arranged.

Wash hands thoroughly after handling even if a leak wasn't obvious.

If medical advice is required, immediately call the National Poisons Centre on 0800764766 or a Doctor

Contact 30 Seconds to arrange collection and a full refund of the affected bottles.

The issue may affect bottles with the following batch numbers purchased between September 2022 and January 2023 from various retail outlets:

Batch numbers are recorded on the back of the bottle near the bottom right hand corner.
